Through the Covid-19 pandemic, the city waived "parking permit fees" and enforcement throughout the entire city which included street/time. Now that California is planning on reopening on June 15, 2021, the Grass Valley Police Department began full parking enforcement on April 1, 2021.

The permitted and limited hours parking areas are, The City Hall parking lot (3 hours parking only), The Grass Valley Police Department (permitted on the Northside of the lot), Richardson St @ N. Auburn Street are both 3 hr. and permit parking; no distinction in spaces, The Pioneer Village which is at the corner of S Auburn St and Neal Street, and 161 ½ S Auburn St. which is behind Network Realty. The Union Square parking lot is 3 hr. parking only.

The permits can be purchased at the Grass Valley Police Department. The \$45.00 permit is good for one quarter (3 months) i.e 04/01 through 06/30 & 07/01- 09/30 etc.
